# Electrical Code

## 680.25 Feeders

*FEEDER: All circuit conductors between the service equipment, the source of a separately derived system, or other power supply source and the final branch circuit overcurrent device.*

These provisions shall apply to any feeder on the supply side of panelboards supplying branch circuits for pool equipment covered in Part II of this article and on the load side of the service equipment or the source of a separately derived system.

(A) Wiring Methods. Feeders shall be installed in rigid metal conduit, intermediate metal conduit, liquidtight flexible nonmetallic conduit, rigid polyvinyl chloride conduit, or reinforced thermosetting resin conduit. Electrical metallic tubing shall be permitted where installed on or within a building, and electrical nonmetallic tubing shall be permitted where installed within a building. Aluminum conduits shall not be permitted in the pool area where subject to corrosion.

Exception: An existing feeder between an existing remote panelboard and service equipment shall be permitted to run in flexible metal conduit or an approved cable assembly that includes an equipment grounding conductor within its outer sheath. The equipment grounding conductor shall comply with 250.24(A)(5).

(B) Grounding. An equipment grounding conductor shall be installed with the feeder conductors between the grounding terminal of the pool equipment panelboard and the grounding terminal of the applicable service equipment or source of a separately derived system. For other than (1) existing feeders covered in 680.25(A), Exception, or (2) feeders to separate buildings that do not utilize an insulated equipment grounding conductor in accordance with 680.25(B)(2), this equipment

grounding conductor shall be insulated.

(1) Size. This conductor shall be sized in accordance with 250.122 but not smaller than 12 AWG. On separately derived systems, this conductor shall be sized in accordance with Table 250.66 but not smaller than 8 AWG.

(2) Separate Buildings. A feeder to a separate building or structure shall be permitted to supply swimming pool equipment branch circuits, or feeders supplying swimming pool equipment branch circuits, if the grounding arrangements in the separate building meet the requirements in 250.32(B). Where installed in other than existing feeders covered in 680.25(A), Exception, a separate equipment grounding conductor shall be an insulated conductor.

The insulated equipment grounding conductor can be aluminum or copper and is required to be installed in a raceway. It should be understood that for an existing remote panelboard, the 680.25(A) Exception permits an approved cable assembly with an insulated or covered aluminum or copper equipment grounding conductor. See Exhibit 680.8.

Swimming pool equipment supplied by a separately derived system is covered in 680.25(B). Where a remote panelboard supplying a pool is supplied by a separately derived system, the rules covering the grounding conductor apply only to the

680.25 Feeders - continued -

feeder between the separately derived system and the panelboard, not all the way back to the service, which might be high voltage.

The general rule in 680.25(B) requires an equipment grounding conductor to be installed between a panelboard serving swimming pool equipment and the service or the source of a separately derived system. Section 680.25(B)(2) allows pool equipment to be supplied from a remote panelboard in a separate building where an insulated equipment grounding conductor is installed with the feeder circuit conductors run from the service (or derived system) to the panelboard and where the installation complies with 250.32(B). See Exhibit 680.9

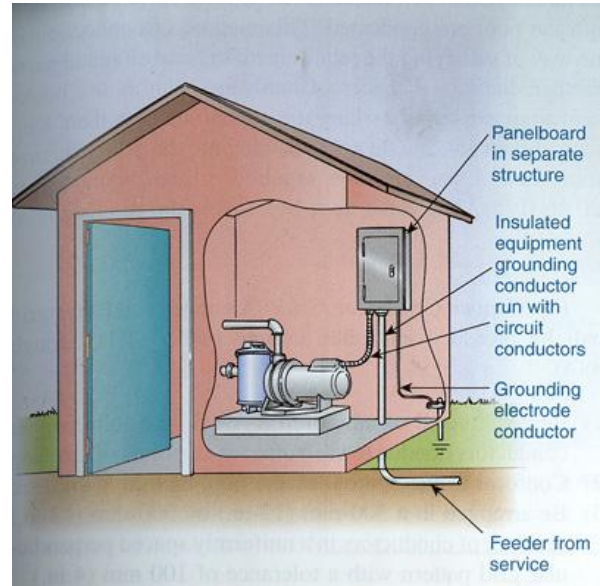


Exhibit 680.9 Grounding requirements per 680.25(B)(2) for remote panelboard and swimming pool equipment located in a structure remote from the service equipment.

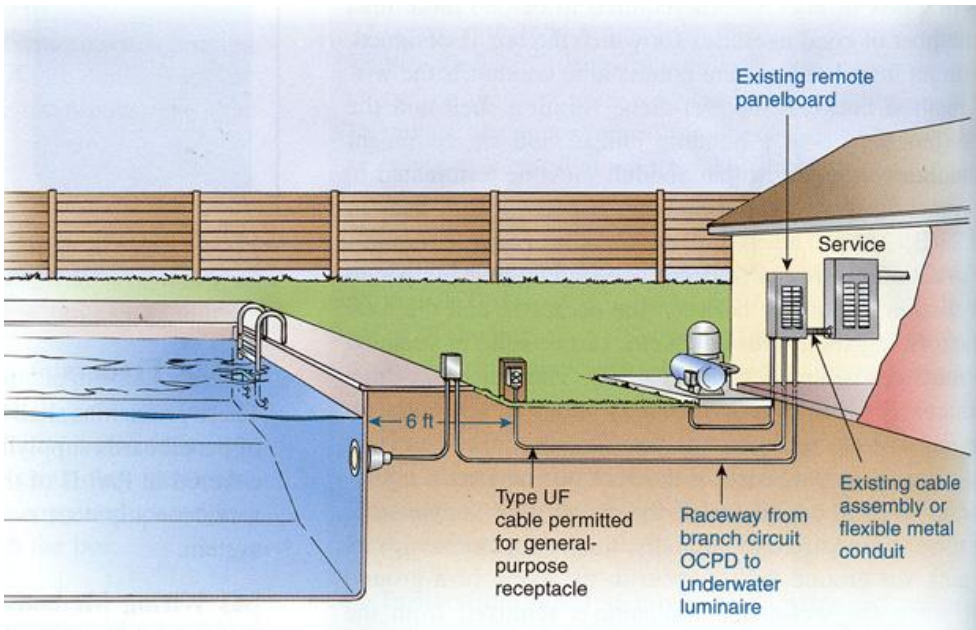

companies to the lead. You must be very careful answering any calls, especially if you do not know the true source. Just say "no". I know it is the hardest word in a small business man's vocabulary. Learn it, try it, no not on your wife, and don't go getting me in trouble. Here is a list of things you must do now!

1. Apply for your test. DO NOT LIE on your paper work to the state. They will run several checks on you. It is a very likely if you have a criminal record or are late/behind on alimony/child support payments that the state will not allow you a license. Lying on the paper work may also get you in jail. Fill in every line.
2. Carry the card from PSI with you at all times, this will act as a get out of jail free card. You have 12 months in which to pass the test.
3. Keep any receipts from training with you as well. (they will not citation

you if you show an effort to get your license)

4. Do not apply for your contractor's part until you have the Appliance installers passed. (once you do pass, then apply, you will be required to show proof of insurance at that time)
5. Get a copy of the 2008 NEC book, with labels
6. attend as many classes as you think is necessary
7. study the book, the exam of 85 questions, of which 5 are not gradable
8. you will have 4 hours to take the test, more if you figure out the five questions that are not TIMED, mark those and go back to them as many times as needed to help you find the correct answers to the others.
9. you will only be able to take in the testing center your keys, (of which will be put into a locker while testing), and the 2008 NEC book, as I understand all copies are now acceptable. They will supply a pencil and a sheet of paper.
10. ONLY high light or under line in your

The IPSSA Water Chemistry Certification Exam is based on IPSSA's Basic Training Manual-Part 1. We have training manuals and workbooks available so you can get yourself prepared. Contact us at [info@ipssafortworth.com](mailto:info@ipssafortworth.com) The exam is offered on-line at no cost. To take the exam on-line, write to [exam@ipssa.com](mailto:exam@ipssa.com) or call 888-360-9505 to obtain a log-in ID and password.

- When requesting a log-in ID and password, we will need your full name, company name, mailing address, telephone number, e-mail address, and the name of the chapter you wish to join (if known).
- You will receive your log-in ID and password no later than the next business day.
- The IPSSA Water Chemistry Certification Exam contains 50 questions.
- You may refer to your copy of the IPSSA Basic Training Manual-Part 1 when taking the exam, but you only have 60 minutes in which to complete it.
- During the 60 minutes you can go back and change answers. You will not be able to answer any questions after your 60 minutes expire.
- You must get 90% or more of the questions right in order to pass. After you have completed the exam on-line, you will be notified of the results immediately.
- There are a limited number of times you can take the exam with the same log-in ID and password.

book. Anything else and the book goes away until you leave.

- 11. Set the test time for as early as possible, so you can finish.
- 12. Call the testing center ahead of time, to verify their rules; every center is a little different.

Other good to know items;

- 1. If you are caught doing electrical work, you can be cited for up to three different levels. Each level can increase the fine, up to \$5000 each, or a \$25000 fine, cease operation and close of business for 2 years. Even jail time. Carrying tools, having them on you, bidding for work (in person or over the phone) doing the work, invoicing, etc. if you are caught they will inspect your truck, your client, and your accounting for as much as 4 years back. Any evidence will get you a fine.
- 2. You will need to label your working trucks, all your paper work, business card, door hangers, web site, etc.
- 3. I have already been contacted by electrical companies informing me that only they can now do the service work, and have been given the state's phone number to turn in "Pool Companies"

- 4. You must have a contractor's license to invoice customers, so even if you pay an electrician to do the work, only they can invoice the customers, and must have all their paperwork on file with the state. You can even go online and see who has the proper licenses.

Scared yet? Sorry, we all must comply. If you have pool "cleaners" whom never touch anything electrical, they do not need to worry. Better not have any of the wrong type of tools on their truck.

ALL IPSSA members will be required to have on file a license. IPSSA will enforce this sometime this year.

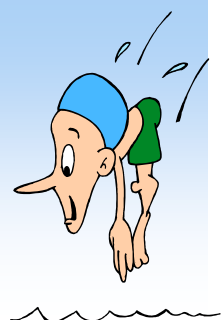
